MORNING TIME

Say this as you say goodbye to your child this morning, "Find a task that needs to be done in school today and go for it! You rock!"



DRIVE TIME

Make a special trip to grab some ice cream or any special treat and tell your child you are going to celebrate! What are we celebrating? Ask them to think about what God has done this week in their life and talk about it while enjoying your special dessert. Maybe it's inviting a new family in the neighborhood for dinner, or cleaning up the trash in an empty lot. Then, don't wait for someone else to do it. Instead, plan a time this week for your family to jump into action. Pray together and ask God to help you follow through.
