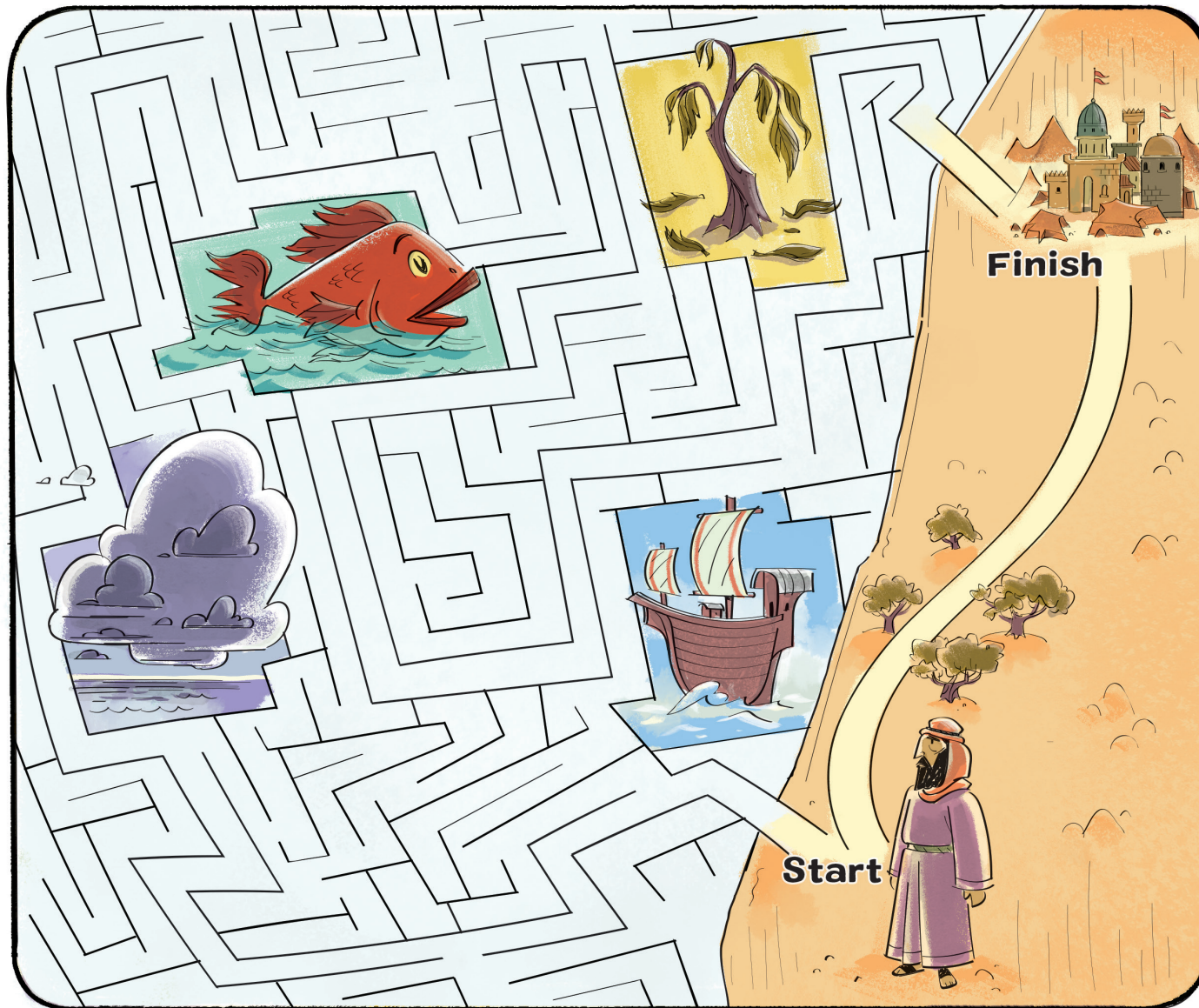


Road to Nineveh

**Jonah, Prophet to
Nineveh**

BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

- God told Jonah, a prophet, to travel to Nineveh and warn them about their coming destruction.
- Jonah went the other way, but God used a giant fish to save Jonah and turn him around.
- Jonah did not want God to save the people of Nineveh.
- God loves all people and showed mercy to the Ninevites.

KEY PASSAGE: 2 Peter 3:9

BIG PICTURE QUESTION:

- Why should we obey God? We should obey God because He made us, He loves us, and His plans are good.

FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:

- Why does God love all people?
- Who do you find difficult to love?
- How can we love all people as God does?

FAMILY ACTIVITY:

- Take your family fishing, or simulate fishing using sticks, string, magnets, and paper clips. See who can catch the biggest fish. Discuss God's mercy and release the fish.

Hosea, Prophet to Israel

BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

- God told Hosea to marry a woman who did not love him the way she should have.
- Hosea's wife was a picture of the people of Israel, who did not love God the way they should have.
- Hosea rescued his wife and paid to get her back.
- God is faithful to His people even when they do not love Him.

KEY PASSAGE: 2 Peter 3:9

- Why should we obey God? We should obey God because He made us, He loves us, and His plans are good.

FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:

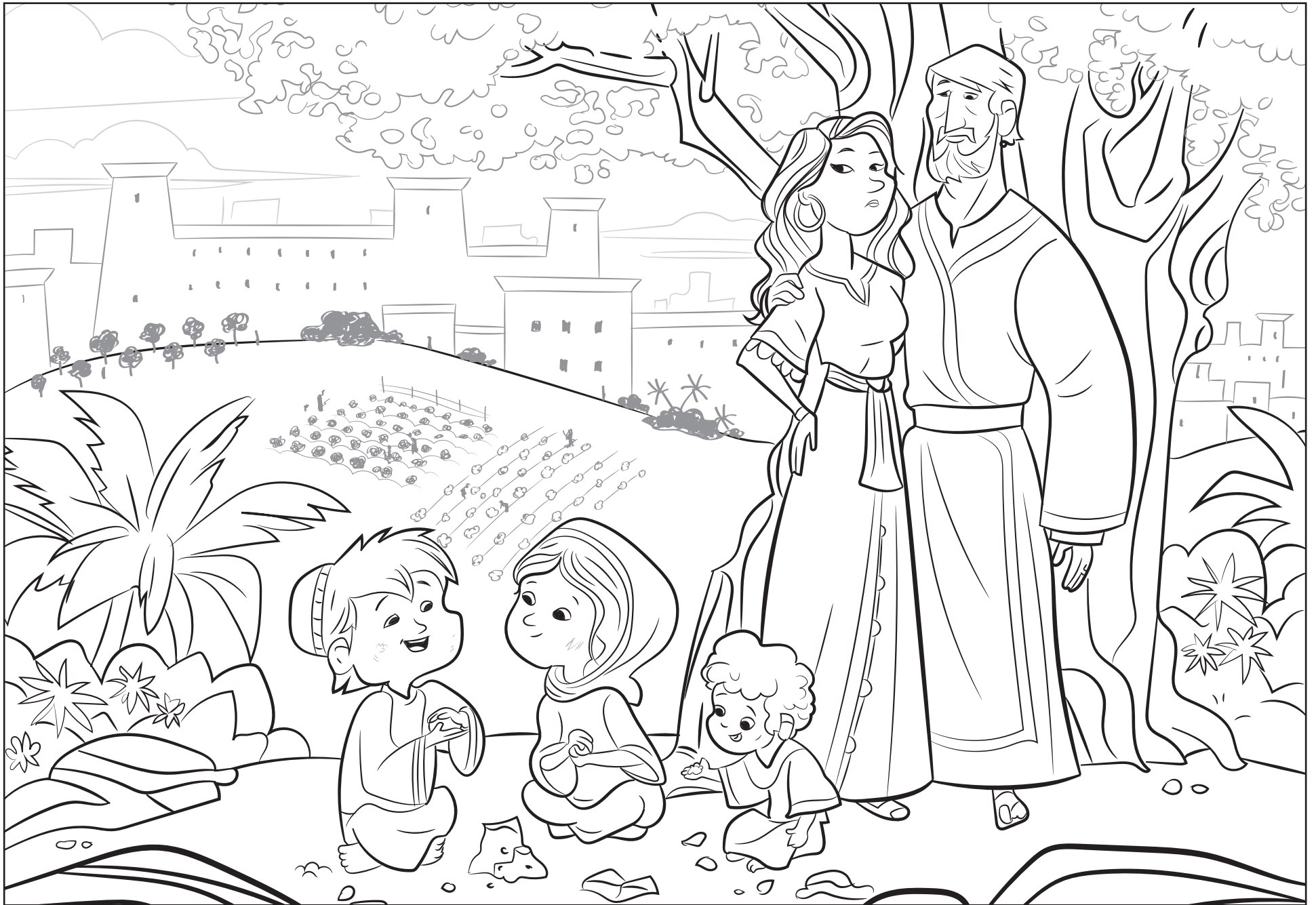
- What price did God pay to rescue us from sin and death?

FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:

- Why don't believers in Jesus need to fear being punished for our sin?
- What kind of consequences might we still face for sin?
- How can we stop sinning and obey God more each day?

FAMILY ACTIVITY:

- Organize a community yard sale with your neighborhood or church. Encourage your kids to help you come up with prices for different items. Discuss how Israel paid the price for their sin. Remind the kids that sin carries a high price, but Jesus paid that price for us.
