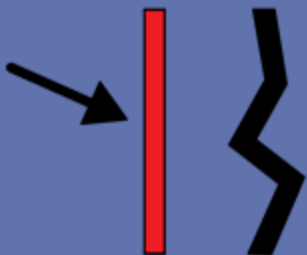

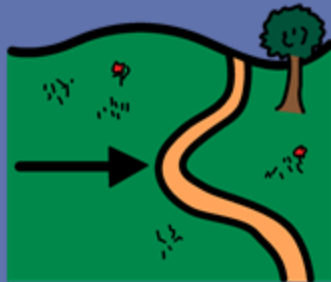

He came with gifts

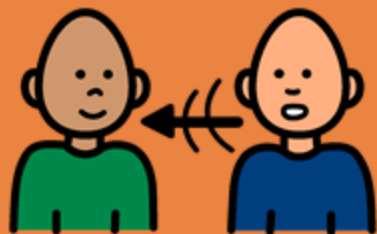

and lied to Elisha



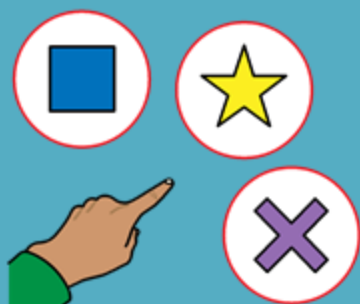

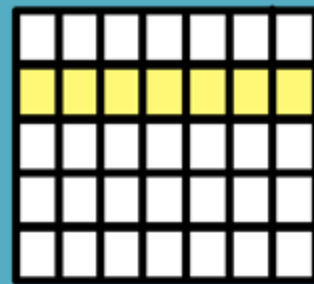

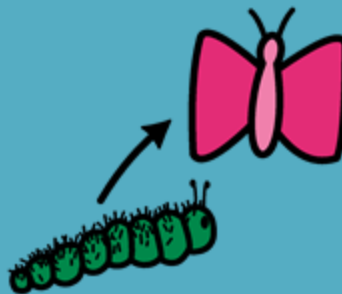
