Gather a small box, wrapping paper, some tape, a piece of paper, and something to write with. Once you have your supplies together, take the piece of paper and write JESUS as big as you can. Fold it up and put it inside the box and wrap it up, just like a gift. Place it under your Christmas tree. On Christmas day, when this present is opened, share with your family that the best gift we could ever have on Christmas is JESUS!

Ask God to help you remember that JESUS is the best gift!

Let's Have Cake!

Ask an adult to help you look up John 3:16. Christmas is a time when we celebrate the birth of Jesus—God's greatest gift. Using craft supplies, draw and decorate a cake that would be fit for celebrating Jesus! Think about what it would look like or what it would say. After, spend some time thanking God for sending Jesus to be our Savior. Pray something like this:

Dear God, Thank You for loving me so much that You sent Your Son, Jesus. Help me celebrate Jesus today and always. I love you, God. Amen.
