One day, God spoke to Moses through a burning bush.




He said, "Moses, Moses!" Here I am," Moses said.

I am the God of Isaac. And I am the God of Jacob."




When Moses heard that, he turned his face away. He was afraid to look at God.

Instead of releasing the Israelites, Pharaoh made them work even harder.






God used miraculous signs through Moses and Aaron, but Pharaoh wouldn't listen.

But still, Pharaoh wouldn't let the people qo.




God called Moses to speak to Pharaoh again and again.

Pharaoh finally let the people go.




