Peter and the other believers continued to



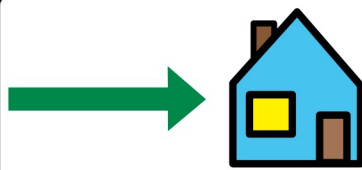
spread the news about Jesus through God's spirit.

So far, the believers only shared about Jesus to Jewish people.



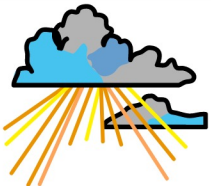
Going into the home of

Cornelius was a Roman commander who lived in Caesarea. He gave



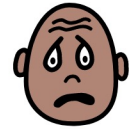
to people in need and worshipped God.



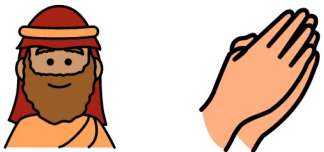
One day, God sent an angel. The angel told Cornelius to go to



Joppa and bring back a man named Peter.



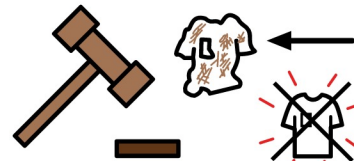
Cornelius was afraid, but he did what the angel had said.



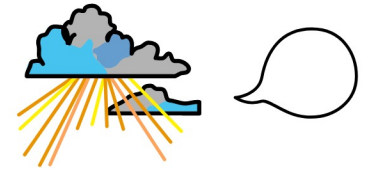
During this time, Peter was praying and



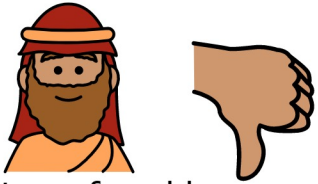
God gave Peter a vision. Peter saw sheep with animals



that Jewish law said were unclean.



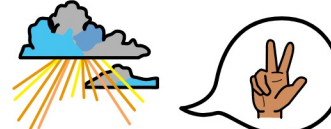
God said, "Get up Peter, kill and eat."

God's spirit spoke to Peter and said, "Three men are looking for you."



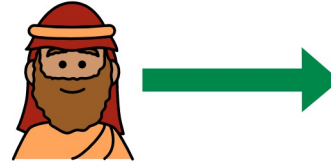
Don't let anything keep you from going with them. I have sent them."



Peter began to understand what God was telling him -



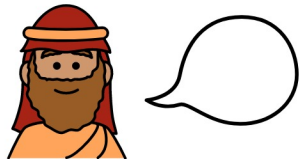

The next day, the men set out for Caesarea.



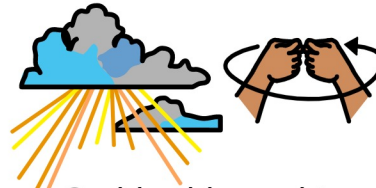
