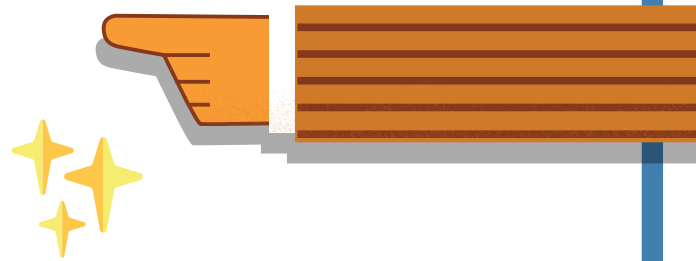
Who loves you?

WEEK 1

Adam and Eve eat the fruit God told them not to eat and have to leave the garden.

Genesis 1:31, 2:8-3:24

Did Adam and Eve eat the fruit that God told them not to eat? (Yes)
Did God still love Adam and Eve? (Yes)

WEEK 2

Moses leads God's people to trust what God says, and God makes a path through the Red Sea for the Israelites to walk on.

Exodus 13:17-18, 14

Who would not let God's people leave Egypt? (Pharaoh, king of Egypt)
Where did God make a dry path for the people to walk? (In the sea)

WEEK 3

Jonah goes God's way and tells the people in Ninevah about God after Jonah goes his own way and is swallowed by a big fish.

Jonah 1:1-3:10

Who told Jonah to go to Ninevah? (God)
What did Jonah do inside the big fish? (Jonah prayed)

WEEK 4

The prophet Elisha told Naaman to wash in the Jordan River to heal his skin.

2 Kings 5:1-14

Why did Naaman need help? (He had boo-boos.)
How many times did Elisha tell Naaman to go in the water? (Seven)
