One day, God called Moses to the top of Mount Sinai.



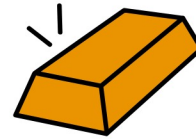

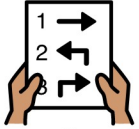

a tabernacle (tent). This tent would be a Holy tent.



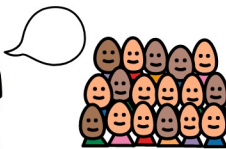
It would be beautiful and highly decorated.



God's instructions for the tabernacle were very specific because



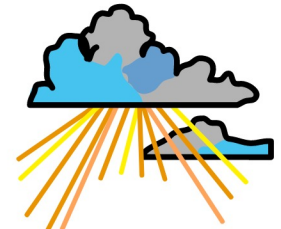
every detail was important.

and another to work with wood and all kinds of crafts.

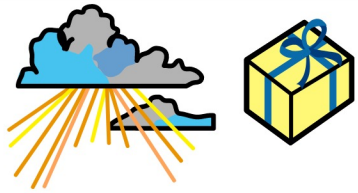


They were also chosen to teach
