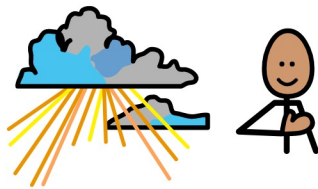
This week, we learn the story of Palm Sunday.

God's promised Savior.



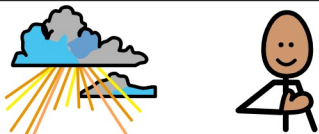
Jesus had been traveling, teaching others how to



love God and love others.



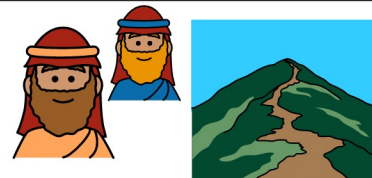
As Jesus' ministry grew, the people were starting to believe that Jesus WAS that Savior.



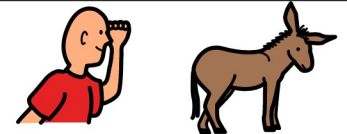
They were sure that God's promises were finally coming true!



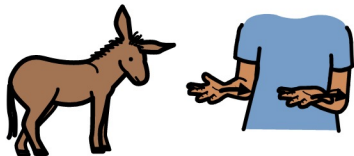
Jesus gave special instructions to two of His disciples

Jesus' disciples did what He asked. They threw their coats

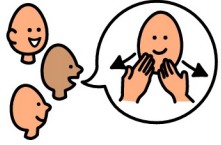


over the donkey for Jesus to ride on.

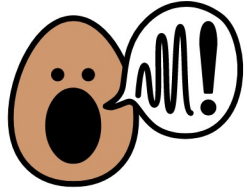


When Jesus entered Jerusalem on a donkey, just as the prophecy was told,

"Hosanna to the Son of David."



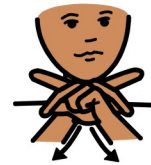
